



2024 SPONSORED GOLFER PROGRAM

Thank you for expressing an interest in the Pinebrook Sponsored Golfer Program.

This summer Pinebrook will be extending an opportunity to non-member Juniors & Intermediates allowing them to experience the first class Pinebrook Program.

OUR OBJECTIVE:

Pinebrook Golf & Country Club is proud to offer the opportunity for young, aspiring golfers to take their passion to the next level with our Sponsored Junior & Intermediate Program. Designed to develop and nurture their skills, this program provides access to special training, exclusive benefits, and a chance to compete at the highest level.

To be eligible for the program, applicants must have demonstrated interest in the game, a desire to progress, and the ability to commit to the expectation of the program. These requirements include regular training, adherence to the rules and regulations of the game, and participation in events and tournaments. Interested candidates must apply by **March 1st, 2024**, as this is the deadline for submissions. After this date, we will be holding interviews with all applicants to determine their level of commitment and qualifications.

We look forward to welcoming the next generation of golfers to Pinebrook and helping them achieve their dreams.

ATTITUDE/BEHAVIOUR:

Pinebrook Junior & Intermediate golfers are expected to conduct themselves with the utmost professionalism, both on the golf course and in the clubhouse. They must adhere to all expectations set out by the Pinebrook Junior Committee and Head Professional. They must be present with their guests on the golf course and on the member-only third level of the clubhouse.

A Sponsored Member is expected to be actively engaged in the club's events and activities throughout the season. At the end of the year, the Committee and Head Professional will review each sponsored golfer's attendance and adherence to all program expectations. Based on this review, a decision will be made regarding the continuation of the sponsored membership.

JUNIORS:

- AGE: Junior Golfers between the ages 13-17 years of age (As of January 1st of the Current Year)
- EXPECTATIONS: Sponsored Juniors at Pinebrook are encouraged to attend the two Junior Information Days in April and the Monday Junior Night Program from May to August. They can also take part in Pinebrook Junior Tournaments including the Junior Opening, Parent/Junior Event, Junior Club Championships, and Junior Member Guest. Additionally, juniors should play a minimum of twenty (20) rounds at Pinebrook, and volunteer to help with the Junior Program when required.
- COST: \$1169.00 + GST = \$1227.45

INTERMEDIATES:

This new membership category is designed for full-time university students, creating a transition between the existing Sponsored Junior Program and Affiliate Intermediate Membership. It will mirror the existing Sponsored Junior Program in execution, including a fee structure that matches Junior or Intermediate member dues based on age.

- AGE: Intermediate Golfers between the ages of 18-24 years of age (As of January 1st of the Current Year)
- EXPECTATIONS: Sponsored Intermediates at Pinebrook are expected to play and practice at the course. In addition, you are required to volunteer your time to help with the Junior Program as needed (20 hours). As a competitive golfer, it is expected that you represent Pinebrook in any tournaments that you play in throughout the summer. You will be encouraged to play in Men's Night and events through the year.
- COST: \$2193.00 + GST = \$2302.65

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Applying for a Sponsored Junior or Intermediate Membership at Pinebrook Golf & Country Club is a great way to get involved in the game of golf. To ensure you have the best chance of success in your application, please follow these steps:

- 1. COMPLETE THE PINEBROOK APPLICATION FORM:** Make sure all the relevant information is included and that all the questions are answered accurately and honestly.
- 2. INCLUDE A COVER LETTER: EXPLAIN WHY YOU ARE INTERESTED IN BECOMING A SPONSORED GOLFER AT PINEBROOK.** Demonstrate your enthusiasm and knowledge of the game, and make sure to include any relevant achievements or experience.
- 3. SUBMIT YOUR MOST RECENT GRADES:** Provide evidence of your academic performance over the past year. Show that you are focused on your studies and that you have the capability to manage your studies alongside your golf activities.
- 4. INCLUDE A REFERENCE LETTER:** Provide a reference letter of endorsement from someone outside of your family (for example a coach, teacher, or friend). This letter should highlight your dedication and commitment to golf.

By following these steps, you can ensure your application for a Sponsored Membership at Pinebrook Golf & Country Club is as strong as possible!
